

6-E | CAN I FILE A CLAIM AGAINST MY BOSS/SUPERVISOR OR OTHER CO-WORKERS UNDER THE FCRA?

While the FCRA (http://www.leg.state.fl.us/Statutes/index.cfm?App_mode=Display_Statute&URL=Ch0760/ch0760.htm) does not permit suits against individuals,⁴² you can still sue individuals who have harmed you under other statutes or judge-made law.

For example, depending on the nature of the harassment which you have experienced, you may have claims against individual supervisors or co-workers for battery (improper touching), invasion of privacy, intentional infliction of emotional distress, or false imprisonment.⁴³
