

12-L | WHAT HAPPENS IF THE INVESTIGATORS DETERMINE THAT NO "REASONABLE" OR "PROBABLE" CAUSE EXISTS ON WHICH TO BASE A CLAIM?

If the FCHR (<http://fchr.state.fl.us/>) determines that there is no reasonable cause to believe a violation has occurred, the claim will be dismissed, but you may still request an administrative hearing before the FCHR within 35 days of the date of the determination.⁹³

If the FCHR fails to render a determination within 180 days, you may either file suit or request an administrative hearing.⁹⁴
