

12-M | WHAT HAPPENS IF THE INVESTIGATOR DETERMINES THAT "REASONABLE" OR "PROBABLE" CAUSE EXISTS ON WHICH TO BASE A CLAIM?

If the FCHR (<http://fchr.state.fl.us/>) determines that there is reasonable cause, you may either file a civil suit against the party named in the complaint in court or request an administrative hearing before the FCHR.^{[95](#)}

If you choose to resolve the violation through an administrative hearing, you must request the hearing within 35 days of the date of the determination of reasonable cause.^{[96](#)}
