

LOCAL RULE 05 | TRIAL EVIDENCE

(a) Exhibits.

See AO 2020-42-Gen.

(b) **Deposition Designations.** No later than **20 days prior to Calendar Call**, each party shall serve his, her or its designation of depositions, or portions of depositions, each intends to offer as testimony in his, her or its case in chief. No later than **10 prior to Calendar Call**, each opposing party shall serve his, her or its counter (or "fairness") designations to portions of depositions designated, together with objections to the depositions, or portions thereof, originally designated. No later than calendar call, each party shall serve his, her or its objections to counter designations served by an opposing party.

(c) **Video Depositions.** Any video deposition which will not be played in its entirety must be edited prior to trial. "Turning down" the audio, to exclude testimony, while the video is playing will not be permitted.

(d) **Joint Pretrial Stipulation Status Conference.** Parties who have not fully complied with the Joint Pretrial Stipulation requirement of the Uniform Pretrial Order or the Division's Procedures may be required to attend a status conference subsequent to calendar call.
