

**IOP 2.4 | SITTINGS AWAY FROM COURT**

The court seeks to conduct at least one oral argument session annually in each of its circuits, as caseload permits. As part of these efforts, the court schedules oral arguments in Pensacola once each calendar year and in Jacksonville twice each calendar year. The court welcomes requests to sit in any community within its district and attempts to coordinate with schools and civic organizations to make these special sessions useful to the community. Requests to sit in any community may be made to either the clerk or the chief judge. The court is also equipped to conduct oral arguments via video teleconference from the other Florida district courts of appeal and some circuit courts.
