

## MEMORANDUM

Enclosed are revisions to the Eleventh Circuit Rules and Internal Operating Procedures (IOPs) that took effect on December 1, 2020. The revisions:

- Delete as unnecessary the portions of 11th Cir. Rules 42-2(c) Dismissal Without Further Notice and 43-2(c) Dismissal Without Further Notice stating that the clerk will “mail a copy” of dismissal orders to counsel and pro se parties. Such orders will continue to be mailed to non-ECF pro se parties in accordance with Federal Rule of Appellate Procedure (FRAP) 45(c).
- Amend FRAP 35, IOP 3 Requesting a Poll and FRAP 35, IOP 6 Polling the Court to state that the chief judge will give other judges a reasonable time to respond to a poll request before conducting a poll on en banc consideration.

The enclosed rules also contain FRAP amendments that took effect on December 1, 2020. A List of Replacement Pages on the following page shows the pages that have changed since the last revision.
