this is my argument my Reply brief
and my name is Doris Gibbs first of
all July 5, 2018 date is wrong I file
this complaint way in 2017 I sent in
materials documents pictures to Florida
Human Commission several times giving
Donta Bonner information telling them
and to show them what was going on
After I complain to the news papers about
Palatka Housing Authority they made my
life a living hell. They became so angry
with me. I could not even get maintane
care in my apt after complaining and
begging to the News paper to Rebecca

at the Palatka Daily News
Rebecca had me to call a lady
by the name of Willie Mae
Someone who work with housing authority
and I did speak to her but they were
still taking to long so I went to the
environmental service for help they said
to me the manager was a Black man
and the Secretary name was Diane or Vicki
He told me he did not do Black mold
only roaches I had roaches also I
call the health dept. the more people I
call or talk to made palatka housing
so upset with me. they took their time
to help me I had already been to
the housing authority and talk to MS
Rebecca Watkins about this mold. She
told me that I needed doctors orders
I told her that I was allergic to the
Black mold and I am also allergic
to roaches. She told me to walk over
to the maintance desk and I did. I saw
a lady maris and I told her that
my apt has Black mold and before she
could speak I heard a deep voice
who said if you clean your apt you
want have mold. I never saw this

man before in my life to talk down to me this way. He had never been in my apt before. They have never inspected my apt before so how could he say that. I am a tenant at this apt building. I am disabled and have asthma real bad. I was under a pulmonary doctor for my breathing instead of taking care of me a disabled woman 64 years old to make sure that I would not die from suffocation. He rather hurt my feelings and tell me I clean up my house. I would not have more. But in the hand book they gave me when I first moved in it said that if I needed maintenance that I would get it. I could not get it what I got was harassment. Retaliated against and week after week curable letters from the housing authority. I did finally get Mr Hobbs to clean up this mold in my laundry room. My doctor even told Palatka housing to get me up somewhere until finish, but they did not do it. I was told to leave my apt with no where to go. about 5 hours later I got

I got a call from Willie Mae telling me I could return home to open up the windows and I did, but when I looked into my laundry it was worse there was Big holes in my ceiling and smeared Black mold all over my walls. They never had painted my apt from the beginning it was dirty. They promise me when I moved in that they would paint but never did. Now I got more damage and the walls had not been painted. I was devastated. I got on the phone this was in November 2017 it took over two weeks to do it and he did not do it right is because he was angry at me for making complaints. I called Mr Hobbs and I call Mr Hobbs and he never came so I call for a grievance meeting. I made a complaint and why did I ever do that? I made this complaint because I could see that Mr Hobbs was not gonna help me. Mr Hobbs friends and my neighbors begin to hassle me. Mrs Anita Carter threaten to whip

me and ms Christine Bowler instead of her saying don't argue leave ms gibbs alone she sided with her against me all because she was angry because the new man move in MR Lomre and ask could he have a veggie garden and I said I don't know why not ms Christine got so upset with me for telling him I don't see why not she said to get away from me I said ms Christine I did not mean any harm. She said again get away from me I walked away in tears I had only only been there a few months when this happen and surely I did not need any enemys I tried to be friendly Then ms willie came by and told me to get rid of my chairs because they were wood, I did not want to lose my apt so I threw them in the garbage I had no room in my apt I Beautiful wooden chairs. I had a trailer and I was told to get rid of it too At the first grievance meeting MR hobbs wore every hat of everyone there except his own when the assistant CEO spoke to Joy MR hobbs took over the conversation

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When she ask or I ask a question, MR Cleveland hobbs answered, He even answered for ms Rebecca Watkins. Then MR hobbs said to me you have the police at your apt all the time and I'm gonna fine out why as if he was threatening me I said or you gonna paint my apt and fix these holes you left and smeared Black mold was all over my walls he said I don't have time I would have to leave your washer and dryer in the middle of the floor I did not care if it stayed in the middle of the floor, my health were more important than that I also ask him to do something about the roaches but he said he did not have the time. there was roach dropping all over my doors front and back door I was coughing sneezing and could not hardly breath because of the dropping and mold I said it needs to be washed and painted, so my husband said If I had the paint I would count it up so my wife want be sick

SO he agreed to get my husband
some paint for the roach droppings
when the whole apt need painting
after he did the doors the next day
he did not come home he was missing
I did not know where he was
I continue to be nausea on my stomach
my head was hurting a lot I was coughing
crying I could not hardly breath I
went back to my doctor over and
over because I could not breath
I was scared because I knew something
was not right. I begin to inspect
my apt and I found so much Black
mold under my kitchen sink inside of
my air condition unit and heat unit closet
and there was so much roach droppings
no wonder I was so sick and could
not get well I have doctors notes
saying after allergg testing that I
was allergic to Roaches and Black mold
green mold, white mold it is toxic
for me but maintain dept did not
come April 17, 2018 when we had
the grievance meeting MR Cleveland
promise my husband enough paint to
cover the roach droppings in the doors

and someone else a white gentleman he was there on April 19 2018 2 days after the meeting and this man patch the holes and painted my laundry room and after he was done. He said sign this paper and I did I had a doctors apt and we all left together. My husband told the man that he would put the washer and dryer back in its place. How about when I got back from my doctors apt MR Cleveland had been inside of my apt. He had put the washer and dryer back. My table cloth had been moved half off of my table when we were doing arts and crafts. He was looking through my things, the work was finish and he had no business in my apt when telling me that he could not finish it it only took six months and I'm a very sick woman a disable woman who needed help and could not get any I have asthma that should have been fixed in a couple of days not six months He made me wait all those months because he was getting back at me

for going to Rebecca at the Palatka
daily news paper. I was not
included in fun time at the apt
Complex everytime there was fun day
I was at all three grievance meetings
that is not a coincidence that
discrimination against I have pictures
of neighbors with things I was not
allowed to have I had to get rid of my
lawn mower grille and my bicycles
I was being punish. One time the wires
burn into on my front eyes and
it was fixed and I signed after it
was fixed, but on May 31, 2018
my stove was not broken only dirty
and I remove the pans so that I
could clean it, that night before
May 31, 2018 I went to the store
I had no way I only had my walker
and after getting my food I notice
the buggy I had was broken so I ask
the manager at the grocery store could
I take it home and bring it back
they knew I used a walker I put my
walker inside of the grocery buggy with my
food and push the buggy to my house
I was feeling so bad I could not finish

Cleaning the stove so I left them ~~on~~ the sink to clean under the stove buggy I push up to my living room window not in no one way I was so sick I went and laid down Early that next morning MR hobbs was banging on my door so hard I made it to the door and he was so nasty he said you need to get this buggy out of here NO one has ever told me not to bring a buggy home with food no one and it was not in the hand book I said okay but since you are here I need you to see what I have been trying to show you all this time on May 23, 2018 I call MR hobbs and ask him and maria to come and get these roaches there was a Roach so big it scared me so I call maintenance MR hobbs told me dont you have family because I'm not coming and he hung up I was on loud speaker with him and maria the Secretary I called back and she said ms gibbs I promise you someone will be there tomorrow I said okay

that 24th day of may no one ever
came so I called maria and she
said he did not come and I said
no. so when I had that opportunity
to see MR hobbs this was my chance
to show him all the mold and roach
droppings. He walked in my apt I was
so happy becau maybe now he will
do this for me I walked over to my
~~the~~ kitchen sink and open up the bottom
door to show him the powder green
and Black mold. When I open up the
door to show him he push the door up
as if he did not want to see it
and brushing it up against my arm.
He looked into my sink and he said
why do you have this out I'm cleaning
it. He said you better put em back
and I pointed up at the hole in
the ceiling and said there is roach
droppings coming out of the vents
and there is mold there too. He said
get up then and put it back ~~and~~
then he saw that I had a box on the
floor he wanted me to move that too
so I said MR hobbs you are not
here to be inspecting me I ask you

to fix these problems mold and roaches but instead he was telling me that I better put the vent door and the pans to the stove back you see he had no business being rude and nasty to me I only wanted help because I have respiratory problems and did not feel good at all. So I said Mr Hobbs if you are not gonna help me just leave he looked at me and walked towards the door and walked out I close my door and he said you are getting out of here I was so upset and crying because not once when I needed help that he help me I was so hurt all over again thinking back on the first time I met him when he told me if I clean my apt I would not have mold, I not only have respiratory problems but also neck and head injuries bad back and hips still under the doctor for that today I have injured both my ankles I have seasonal allergies head hurts a pinched nerve in my lower back plus I

have a learning disability only
8th grade education and most of
my life I've been under doctors at
Ridgeview mental health center
in Oakridge town, for depression
and now since all this has happen
Iland doctors in East Palatka, Florida
put me on anxiety pills because of
all the stress Palatka housing put me
through I have never been on anxiety
pills until 2018 while living in
Annie Mae Spells apt under Palatka
housing authority I had to go to
Matchem mental health in Palatka
MR Kowen my attorney from legal aid
in Palatka, Florida gave this information
to Palatka housing but they ignored
MS Cooper from the HUD office
gave them more information about
my mental status when I was under
another doctor in Sturgis Michigan
Psychological Services and she
also took a copy of my Cheek
Palatka housing gave back to me after
keeping my June 3rd rent for a
month and a half It was return
in certified mail around July 15th 2018

After MR Cleveland left
 I call the police I was so upset
 I call 911 and have proof of it
 The 100 pictures I sent to Florida
 Human relations I never got it back
 from Donta Bonner or the other
 Investigator I feel like they all are
 against The police came to me because I
 call and told that MR Hobbs was
 harrasing me and threatening me but
 When the police came and talk to
 me and when I told her who this
 man was she rushed over to talk
 to him I heard him tell her to
 arrest me he told the officer that I
 hit him push him something like that
 she said turn around you are under
 arrest and I said for what then
 she said you hit Cleve and I said
 no and you cant prove this, then
 she said and you stole this buzzer
 from the store I said that's not
 true and ~~my~~ word is against his
 word then she left me alone
 and went back outside to talk to
 him again. She was out there for
 a long time so I said I'm going to

the store to take this buggy back by the time I got close to the entrance of my apt building the police shot out pass me and I could see through the opening of the gate that MR hobbs were leaving too. He was getting inside of his truck but when he saw me, he got back out of the truck and went over to MS cat apt #902 and MR Johnson in #904 went to MS cat apt 9150 by the time I made it to my door I was out of breath so I sat on my seat on my walker and I could hear them making fun of me the lady in #802 screamed out I want even put you out of my house laughing Everything was still and I was not really trying to listen but it was so loud I couldn't help but to hear Cleveland hobbs call me crazy and he wanted me out MS cat said she ought to just leave she see y'all dont want her here and MR Johnson said while laughing is she really crazy Cleveland and he said yeah ~~and~~ And MR Johnson said I did not know she was crazy I be riding her in my

MS Cat said some body gonna
kill her and my heart dropped
and MR hobbs said I got a
bullet for her that scared me
so bad I went into my apt
tied up the door with station con
rope with whatever I could find
and I push my walker up against the
door with a bucket of water in it
so I could hear if they tried to
come kill me I was so scared
now not only do MS Christine
and MS Anita hate me now he
is turning MS Cat and MR
Johnson against me. My whole body
ache my head hurt and I could
hardly breath I laid down on my
bed still had not seen my husband
I was a nervous wreck everyone
hated me and all I wanted was
some help my husband was gone
and I had no family there I
was so alone. About 6 o'clock
there was a knock on the door
and I did not want to get up
but I did get up and went to
the door it was Cleveland hobbs

⑦ He said here, I am evicting you. He told me he was gonna get me out. But I close my door quickly and would not take it. I was a little afraid because I did not know what he might do to me, they wanted me dead But what I don't understand. If he said MR hobbs told police I hit him. And I was not arrested. When he tried to get the officer to arrest me and for stealing a buggy but there was no proof. So he decided to evict me by going through Housing Authority. If I did something to you then why did you come back without the police or some one with you. They could have sent any one but Cleveland hobbs. The reason he came back to show me what he could do to me. I had not done anything to MR hobbs. He was bullying me harassing me and retaliating against me because I complain on him and he is mad. When he came to my apt about the store buggy it was for not other reason than to evict me.

18) They took away everything I had
but the other tenants had trailers
lawn mowers Bar and bar stools
Entertainment center sofa table one lady
had about 100 water gallon milk jugs
filled up with water when she had a water
hose and they said nothing all this on
the front porch and I only had two
chairs on my porch. Cleveland hobbs told
me that I was not suppose to use the
the garden spot unless I ask Every body had
flowers and ms christine continued to
sit on ms Anitta's porch laughing at me
never saying a word while ms Anitta call me
name she was laughing I was so afraid
for my life I was sick from the mold
and roaches but more afraid of what
they might do to me I stayed inside locked
up not knowing the unknown ms spells in
apt # 204 said you ought to me before they put
your things in the street ms Cooper from Hnd
also told me you should go ahead and move
I had no one and I found out at the second

19 grievance that my husband was in jail
for real, I did not know where
he was and now they have put
his charges against me too I have lost
everything I had I have been living in
abandon vans without lights, water
no proper Bathroom to use or bath
I was using the rest room outside
and not taking many baths. And when
someone did let me come in for a night
it was to get money from me

Palatka housing did this to me
all I wanted was help trying to
save my life from all the toxins
Roach poop and mold is not healthy for
some one like me for no one, so I am
asking you to really look at this evidence. I
have pictures not the hundred from him, others
from my apt, I have evidence and a witness
who saw the living conditions and he painted over
roach poop between the doors. I am disabled I

⑩ get SSD Social Security disability
I get SSI also for disability

So you see They all knew what they were doing to me was wrong

Felicia Tilley had to help me and my husband fill out the application to move in she told us what to do He has a learning disability so we both only went to the 9th grade All we wanted was a place to live and be treated fair I could not enjoy my front porch they made me throw away my chairs Everyone is enjoying my things because I had no where to take it and now I cannot get into housing because they said I owe them they gave me back my rent and force me out threatening my life so I left and lost everything I had I was not court ordered out nor was I arrested for assaulting MR hobbs This was discrimination against me because I am disabled no education and have some mental problems. They took advantage of me

and Palatka housing is covering
up for what they did to me

And when I ask the House manager
for my apt to be painted

She told me Jay Fincher did She said

there was more important things they
had to do more than painting my apt

I was denied everything important

Small things that could save my
life I could not get from my

house manager. Jay Fincher Mrs Rebecca Watkins

She felt that it was more important to get a

doctors note to get help, and still I go no help

it was always a put down, saying things about me

that was not even true. They know they did me

wrong they offend me last week Palatka housing

lawyer call me and offered me 2,500 dollars

to walk away I cant do it because I did

nothing wrong I have lost everything and 2,500

is what Palatka housing think it's worth for
discriminating against me.

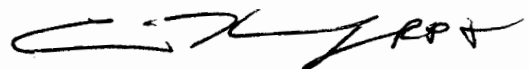

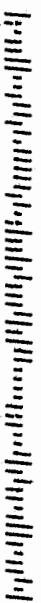

On Wednesday, June 6, 2018, you contacted *Community Legal Services of Mid-Florida, Inc.* for assistance with a landlord/tenant issue. The Palatka Housing Authority was attempting to terminate your housing based upon a non-curable violation of your lease. Specifically, the allegations that you caused a physical altercation with one of the PHA's employees and based upon your husband's unlawful drug activities was the basis for said termination.

After an examination of the facts and discussing the issue at length with you, we prepared to represent you at the informal hearing. After some discussion, we were able to successfully negotiate a potential settlement of all matters. This grounds for the stipulation required that you voluntarily leave the premises within a stated period and in return the housing authority agreed not to pursue an eviction. This would have theoretically preserved your ability to obtain subsidized housing elsewhere. After some reflection, you changed your mind and decided to defend the termination. This was against my best advice.

We again represented you at the second informal hearing, one brought upon the amended notice. The results were disappointing yet expected. At the end of the hearing, you announced that you were terminating my representation of you and have since reiterated said decision in a voicemail. As such, I will no longer be representing you moving forward.

That said, please recall that you are entitled to a hearing pursuant to §966.55 of the Federal Regulations and Palatka Housing Authority's Grievance Policy. You have only 10 days from the date of the Notice, which was August 1, 2018, to request a formal grievance hearing

Please be advised that this memo is meant to document a conversation that took place on Monday, June 25, 2018 between me (Office of Resident Services) and Ms. Cheryl Williams, DCF Adult Case Manager and In-home Caregiver.

Ms. Williams contacted me regarding Mrs. Doris Gibbs, a resident at the Annie M. Spell Senior Community, Apt. 104. Ms. Williams provides in home support services to Mrs. Gibbs. The call was to inquire if Ms. Gibbs had contacted our office regarding mold and mildew in her apartment unit. Mrs. Gibbs complained that her apartment has excessive mold and mildew buildup and that she contacted the PHA Maintenance Department to address the problem but was not satisfied with the results.

Ms. Williams also asked if we had been informed that she (Mrs. Gibbs) "feels" unsafe in her apartment and that she is "afraid for her life." I told Ms. Williams that I have not had the opportunity to speak with Ms. Gibbs or have any knowledge of her concerns. However, I did share that I am aware of an "incident" that occurred involving Mrs. Gibbs, our Director of Maintenance, and the Palatka Police Department but am not privy to the details. I also understand that Mrs. Gibbs has requested a Grievance Hearing in response to a termination of lease notice based on ongoing issues associated with infractions of the tenant lease agreement.

Our conversation concluded with Ms. Williams disclosing that during her regular visits with Mrs. Gibbs, she has not noticed any excess mildew and/or mold in the apartment unit or any indicators that her overall safety is at risk. I agreed to follow-up with the Maintenance Director and Housing Management regarding Mrs. Gibbs concerns.

On May 31, 2018, Management received information that you shoved a PHA employee in his back, Cleveland Hobbs, out of your dwelling unit, after you did not agree with unauthorized conditions in the unit in which you reside being pointed out to you. Deputies with the Putnam County Sheriff's Office (PCSO) responded to your unit and obtained a statement from Mr. Hobbs. Your action against a PHA employee is in direct violation of the dwelling lease agreement. This incident is documented in PCSO's Offense report number 18-001430.

PHA recently discovered that your husband/ household member, Tommy Gibbs, engaged in drug-related criminal activity. On May 26, 2018, Tommy Gibbs was a passenger in a vehicle that was pulled over by deputies for various traffic infractions. After the vehicle was pulled over, Tommy Gibbs exited the vehicle and began walking very fast away from the vehicle. Deputies ordered Gibbs to stop and he continued to walk quickly away from the deputies. During this time, deputies observed Gibbs throw a pill bottle next to a large oak tree. In the pill bottle, deputies retrieved and identified 4 green oxycodone pills, 4 white dilaudid pills, 5 white tramadol pills, 20 pink morphine pills (all controlled substances). Gibbs did not provide a prescription for any of the above-described substances. The driver, Ike Burton, informed deputies that there was marijuana in the vehicle after they smelled a strong odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle. Deputies found the clear baggie containing marijuana on the driver's floorboard. Based on Tommy Gibbs conduct, he was arrested and charged with Resisting/Obstructing without Violence, Possession of Controlled Substance without Prescription (4 counts). Ike Burton was charged with Possession of Marijuana. This incident is documented in PCSO's Offense report number 18-0002612.

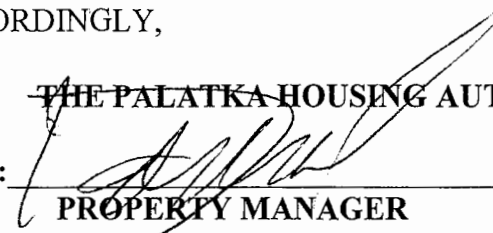

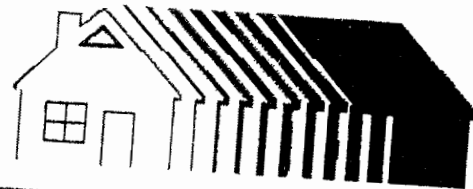

The Appeals Council May Review My Decision On Its Own

Discussion:

Mrs. Gibbs was asked to open the hearing by stating her grievances. She stated that she feels that the PHA and other residents at Annie M. Spell (AMS) have been harassing her, particularly the resident of Apt. 201 (Christine Bolden) and her daughter. Mrs. Gibbs laid out the history of the harassment and detailed a disagreement with Ms. Bolden regarding the planting of food versus flowers in the community planting spaces. Mrs. Gibbs indicated she and Ms. Bolden no longer speak.

The discussion moved then to issues that Mrs. Gibbs had with the PHA, specifically regarding a trailer that was blocking space in the front. PHA asked her to move the trailer, which she has done, but she still claims this is causing talk among her neighbors.

Mrs. Gibbs was also asked by Mr. Hobbs to remove non-compliant chairs from her front porch (only outdoor-type chairs are permitted). She did this, discarding the chairs entirely. She was advised this was unnecessary, and that she merely had to move them inside.

A mildew issue from last year was brought up and it was explained to Mrs. Gibbs that, upon further examination of her unit there was no longer any evidence of mildew. However, the finish on the ceiling has been damaged by the mildew mitigation. Mr. Hobbs promised to address this and have the area repainted by the end of this week.

Mrs. Gibbs indicated that all of these different issues, especially those concerning Ms. Bolden and her daughter, are contributing to her overall stress level. She also made a statement that Mrs. Tinch had left an inappropriate "text" using a racial slur. Upon further discussion, this "text" was in fact a transcribed voicemail that had incorrectly transcribed Mrs. Tinch's message. Mrs. Gibbs, although initially skeptical, eventually realized there was no intent to upset.

Regarding the ongoing situation with Ms. Bolden, Mr. Hobbs has advised her and her daughter not to park in front of Mrs. Gibbs unit. Additionally, Mr. Hobbs said he would follow up on an incident regarding the tenant(s) at another AMS unit in which the police were called.

After the discussion, Mrs. Gibbs seemed satisfied with the efforts PHA is making to ensure she has safe and sanitary housing, and the hearing was concluded.

Dear Ms. Gibbs:

I am in receipt of your letter dated April 9, 2018. Your first complaint deals with the issue that you had with mildew in your apartment. From my understanding with our Director of Maintenance that issue was addressed at the end of last year and we have no record of any new issues from you regarding the mildew since then. I have spoken to the Director of Maintenance and he will come out there to see if the mildew is still clear and if the unit needs to be painted. Please remember if you have a maintenance issue you can call the office anytime and have your work order added to the work log.

The 7 day notice that you were issued regarding the trailer and debris behind your apartment came to me from the Executive Director, John Nelson and Director of Maintenance, Cleveland Hobbs on two different occasions. The first time it was brought to my attention we spoke on the phone about it. The second time you were issued a notice. You left two messages on the phone that I received when I got to work Monday morning April 9th letting me know that you moved the trailer and cleaned up the area behind the house. That satisfied the notice and fixed the issue with the trailer and debris.

You mentioned that you feel that your neighbors do not like you for various reasons and that you told our Director of Social Services Aaron Robinson. The housing authority cannot control the feelings of your neighbors.

Lastly, you say in your letter that I issued you a notice not knowing if it's true or not. If an issue is brought to us from management we issue a notice and then the tenant remedies the situation. You did this by removing the debris from your back porch and moving the trailer. As far as the housing authority is concerned that issue is now taken care of.
